



Petition for Individual Approval

An applicant who is 18 years or older and who is not a graduate of an accredited high school or private school, and who has not earned a GED certificate, may be considered for admission by individual approval. In order to be considered for individual approval, the applicant must:

- complete and submit the South Plains College Application for Admission
- provide an official transcript from the last school attended
- take the TSI Assessment test, regardless of TSI-waived certificate program selected, and
- provide documentation verifying the completion of high school diploma or equivalent when completed

The applicant's TSI Assessment test scores will determine the student's eligibility and course placement. General admission to the college does not guarantee admission to some technical education and health occupation programs, which have additional admission requirements. Please contact the appropriate program advisor for information. Students being admitted under individual approval may not be eligible for student financial aid.
