



SOUTH PLAINS COLLEGE REQUEST FOR INDIVIDUAL APPROVALS

(Applicants without a recognized high school diploma or equivalent)

Adults 18 years or older who have not completed a recognized high school diploma or equivalent may be admitted on an “Individual Approval” basis. The Dean of Admissions and Records will review the application for admission for individual approval.

The applicant must adhere to the following requirements:

- Complete an application for admission.
- Provide official transcript from last school attended.
- Complete TSI Assessment, regardless of TSI waived certificate program selected, to determine the student’s readiness for the college’s curricular offerings.
- Provide documentation verifying the completion of high school diploma or equivalent, when completed.

The applicant’s high school grade level completed and their TSI Assessment test scores will determine the student’s eligibility for Individual Approval for admission and course placement. Admission to the college does not guarantee admission to all programs of the college.
