#### **GENERAL COURSE OUTLINE**

This course is a continuation of functional keyboard skills in Music 2181 with greater emphasis on advanced harmonization and appropriate technical skills. It is designed as a preparation for the piano proficiency exam for the music major but is also open to any interested student. The course meets two 45-min classes each week.

### **EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES**

Upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

- 1. Sight-read intermediate level repertoires by understanding more complicated rhythmic/melodic patterns and articulations.
- 2. Continue Comfortably play technique routines in both Major and minor keys and utilize them to accompany a soloist in collaborative performances.
- 3. Perform advanced intermediate level piano repertoires in various styles with confidence in a live performance setting.

#### METHODES FOR ASSESSING EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

*The expected learning outcomes will be assessed through:* 

In-class/virtual performances, class preparation, quizzes, various musical activities, exams, and virtual recital.

### **GRADES CALCULATED**

- 1. Class Preparation (20%): Students are expected to diligently practice and accomplish their assignment duties for each class.
- 2. Midterm (15%): Students should prepare and present their learning progress for technique routines and one repertoire.
- 3. Piano Proficiency Exam (25%): Students are responsible for accomplishing piano proficiency requirements and passing the exam.

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- 4. Final Recital Performance (25%): Students will perform one repertoire by memory and submit a recording. The final recital will be <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 08, 2024</u>, at 1 <u>PM</u>.
- 5. Class Attendance (15%): Students are expected to attend every class in person.
