## SOUTH PLAINS COLLEGE IMPROVES EACH STUDENT'S LIFE

<u>Course Description</u>: This course provides an overview for workers in the electrical industry of regulations and guidelines which require safety training. Topics include the 29CFR 1910, 1926, and NFPA 70E standards such as confined space entry, lock out/tag out, arc flash and other work related subjects.

<u>Course Learning Outcomes</u>: The goals/objectives of this course are:

To be able to locate and explain electrical hazards. Discuss safety issues concerning lock out/ tag out procedures and arc flash. Locate an interpret Safety Data Sheets (SDS). Discuss various OSHA and NFPA 70E regulations for electrical and other industries. Fill out a job hazard analysis.

<u>Course Competencies</u>: Upon successful completion of this course, each student will have demonstrated through comprehensive examinations, with a score of 70% or better, a competent understanding of:

Safe work habits and responsibilities as required by OSHA.

Terminology, facts, and concepts pertaining to safe work habits.

Technical and academic information necessary for work to be conducted safely.

The duties and responsibilities of workers to themselves and their employer to work without injury.

<u>Academic Integrity:</u> The attempt of any student to present as his or her own work which he or she has not honestly performed is regarded by the faculty and administration as a most serious offense and renders the offender liable to serious consequences, possibly suspension. If you have a question as to whether you may work with other students on any assignment, ASK YOUR INSTRUCTOR.

<u>Assignment Policy:</u> All required work must be turned in on time in order that the student may benefit from the corrections and study for future examinations. Assigned outside work is DUE ON THE CLASS PERIOD ASSIGNED. The instructor has sole discretion as to whether late work is acceptable.

<u>Attendance Policy:</u> Students are expected to attend all classes in order to be successful in a course. The student may be administratively withdrawn from the course when absences become excessive as defined in the course syllabus. Students with four (4) or more absences MUST contact their instructor.

When an unavoidable reason for class absence arises, such as illness, an official trip authorized by the college or an official activity, the instructor may permit the student to make up work missed. It is the student's responsibility to complete work missed within a reasonable period of time as determined by the instructor.

<u>Students with illness related or other absences must communicate with the instructor for those absences to be excused.</u>
